I.

Qualifications: Candidates must hold a Ph.D. degree in journalism, communication, or related fields.

Priority will be given to the following research/teaching expertise: digital journalism theory and practice, international communication, multimedia creation and narrative, communication effect research, interdisciplinary studies of journalism, and communication, experience in media practice.

The ability to teach in English is preferred.

II. Rank: Assistant Professor or above, two positions available.

III. Expected Starting Date: August 1, 2024.

IV. Required Documents:

1. Please merge all documents into a single PDF file in the following order:

(1) Cover Letter (A4 one page limit)

(2) A detailed academic CV (including the main academic experience, list of publications, current job, and contact information).

(3) The highest degree certificate.

(4) Up to five important academic publications from the past five years.

(5) For those who have obtained a Ph.D. degree within the past three years, please attach the dissertation and proof of academic records from your Ph.D. program.

(Please provide an English summary if the dissertation is not written in Chinese or English.)

(6) Teaching materials: Provide course syllabi for at least two areas of expertise. For those with teaching experience, include relevant teaching evaluation materials.

2. Two letters of recommendation.

For applicants seeking the rank of Assistant Professor, two full letters of recommendation are required. Candidates qualified for the rank of Associate Professor or higher should include only the names, current positions, and contact information of two recommenders in their CV.

Recommenders are requested to submit the recommendation letter as a PDF file, and send it to the official email address of the institute (cpl@ntu.edu.tw) with the
